## **Visitors Reports:**

### **City of Glendale:**

- **Ani Pogossian** (Economic Development) No new parklet news to report. Police services for the upcoming Arts and Crafts Festival were discussed.
- **Jennifer Coronado** reported that all restaurants in the MSP will be contacted soon regarding changes in use of single-use plastics in favor of compostable products; Mark and Dale will be giving Jennifer merchant contact information.
- MSPA members informed **Tad Dombrowski** that the blind spots on Wickham Way need to be addressed. Tad reported that he is working on Merchant Parking solutions.
- **Glendale PD:** It was brought to the attention of Officer Aaron Eggiman that there have been repeated issues of a homeless man causing disturbances including yelling, screaming profane language, and encampment setup near 3600 Oceanview Blvd. Officer Eggiman will investigate and will follow up with GPD regarding police coverage for the Montrose Arts and Crafts Festival.

## **Contractors Reports:**

- Steve Pierce (MSPA Communications Administrator) reported on the following: The Memorial Day Ceremony went well; Steve expressed a need for help with the growing homeless issues in the MSPA; the parking lot behind "Toasted" is unclean and needs attention; the Montrose Bowl's recent sidewalk plumbing/repair is a concern during the upcoming Arts and Craft Festival.
