Staff Reports:

- Business Administrator/Event Coordinator: Dale Dawson reported on remaining past due MSPA assessments. The MSPA newsletter will be going out soon with the subjects of The Montrose Film Fest, Montrose Gardens. He announced that the fall pole banners are up and the Directory Boards have been updated. The sidewalk power wash will be done after Oktoberfest. Lot B is being patched now and will be slurry coated at a later date. The Car Show was the best attended ever; MSPA scrip that was given out can be used in restaurants, retail stores, salons as well as any participating MSP business. Bids for the seasonal lighting contract were presented; the Board voted to continue with the current contractor for 2015/2016. He also reported complaints from businesses issues with Parkwood Maintenance blowing debris under doorways; he requested an increase in the maintenance budget from \$500/year to \$800/year for maintenance of the Vietnam War Memorial.
