Our Rules & Information

Please Read Thoroughly...*Very Important!*

- ✓ 1. You must observe all rules regarding exhibitor arrival, access and parking. (See pages “**Exhibitor Booth Location Map**” and “**Exhibitor Access and Parking**”).
- ✓ 2. Each block has designated volunteers there to guide you in, answer questions and provide assistance as needed. In addition, there will be an information booth located on Ocean View Blvd. at Honolulu Ave. staffed at all times.
- ✓ 3. Event managers and volunteers will be wearing T-shirts designating them as EVENT personnel so that you will be able to easily recognize them.
- ✓ 4. When setting up, please do not obstruct open aiseways, sidewalks, garden areas or turf with personal articles such as chairs, handbags (secure those carefully!), totes, merchandise, inventory, boxes, etc. You must set up within your assigned space! Exhibitors will be sharing the event area with nearly 175 local storeowners who are conducting business during the Festival. To ensure consideration, cooperation and politeness, this request will be strictly enforced.
- ✓ 5. Please note that posters, banners or similar signage reading “Sale,” “Discount,” “Show Specials,” “Compare Prices” and the like are not permitted.
- ✓ 6. Festival hours are: Saturday, June 3rd from 10 AM until 6 PM
Sunday, June 4th from 10 AM until 5 PM
- ✓ 7. Advertising for this event is extensive and includes social media as well as newspaper and magazine ads in the following publications: Crescenta Valley Weekly, Glendale News Press, Burbank Leader, La Canada Valley Sun, Pasadena Weekly, Santa Clarita: The Signal Newspaper as well as Beacon Media which serves Pasadena, Monrovia, Arcadia & Sierra Madre.

- ✓ 11. Please read the attached page “**Fire Safety**” to familiarize yourself with the location of fire extinguishers throughout the event area.



Fire Safety !

The Glendale Fire Department requires fire extinguishers every 300 feet along the Festival route. Please familiarize yourself with the placement of these extinguishers by noting the booth numbers below and their corresponding locations on the “**Exhibitor Booth Location Map.**”

Exhibitor Access & Parking

If you are an **Artist, Crafter or Packaged Food Vendor**, you will enter the event area as follows:

If your space is located in the 2200 Block of Honolulu Ave.

If you are traveling on the 210 Foothill Freeway, exit at Ocean View Blvd. and travel South on Ocean View to Montrose Ave. (first signal). Turn left onto Montrose Ave. Follow Montrose Ave. east until it makes a bend to the south. As it does so, queue-up to enter Honolulu Ave. from the right turn lane at the east entrance to the Montrose Shopping Park.

If you are traveling on the “Glendale 2 Freeway north, merge onto the 210 Foothill Freeway West toward San Fernando. Exit the 210 at La Crescenta Ave. and turn left (South) onto La Crescenta Ave. Head South on La Crescenta Ave. to Montrose Ave. and turn left. Follow Montrose Ave. east until it makes a bend to the South. As it does so, prepare to queue-up in the right turn lane at Honolulu Ave. at the East entrance to the Montrose Shopping Park.

If your booth is located in the 2300 Block of Honolulu Ave.

...And you are traveling on the “Foothill 210 Fwy”, exit at Ocean View Blvd. Travel South on Ocean View Blvd. to Honolulu Ave. (third signal). Prepare to queue-up in the right turn lane at Honolulu Ave.

If you are traveling on the “Glendale #2 Fwy”, merge onto the “Foothill 210 Fwy” West toward San Fernando. Exit the 210 at La Crescenta Ave. and turn left (South) onto La Crescenta Ave. Head South on La Crescenta Ave. to Montrose Ave. and turn left. Follow Montrose Ave. to Ocean View Blvd. and turn right. Take Ocean View South to Honolulu Ave. (second signal) and prepare to queue-up in the right turn lane at Honolulu Ave.

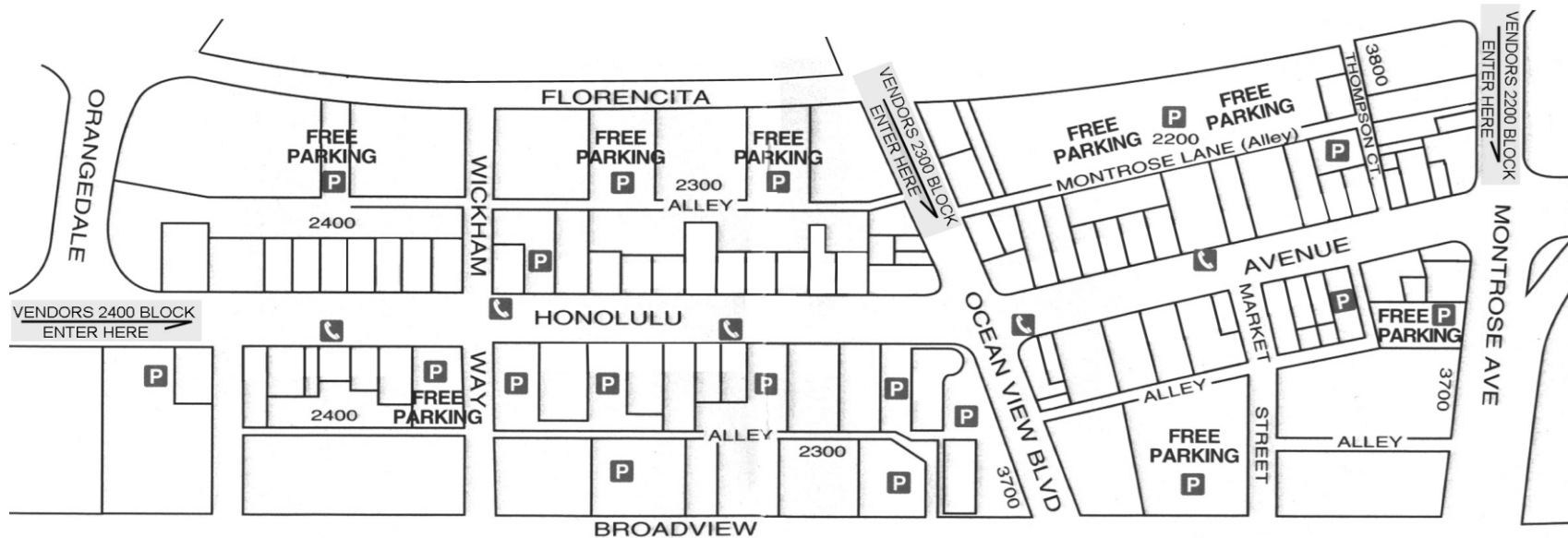
If your booth is located in the 2400 Block of Honolulu Ave.

...And you are traveling on the “Foothill 210 Fwy”, exit at Pennsylvania Ave. and travel South on Pennsylvania Ave. until it bends East and becomes Honolulu Ave. Travel East on Honolulu Ave. and prepare to stop and queue-up at Orangedale Ave. at the West entrance to the Montrose Shopping Park.

If you are traveling on the “Glendale #2 Fwy”, merge onto the “Foothill 210 Fwy” West toward San Fernando. Exit the 210 Fwy at La Crescenta Ave. and turn left (South) onto La Crescenta Ave. Head South on La Crescenta Ave. to Honolulu Ave. and turn left (East). Travel East on Honolulu Ave. and prepare to stop and queue-up at Orangedale Ave. at the West entrance to the Montrose Shopping Park.

(NOTE: DO NOT VARY FROM THESE DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS. EACH BLOCK HAS ITS OWN ENTRY AND EXIT POINTS. OTHER VENDORS WILL BE ACCESSING THE FESTIVAL FROM ENTRY POINTS DIFFERENT FROM YOUR OWN. VENDORS ATTEMPTING TO ENTER AT INCORRECT ACCESS LOCATIONS WILL BE TAKEN OUT OF LINE AND SENT BACK AROUND!)

Exhibitor Parking is Available Along Broadview Dr.

The parking limits will not be enforced along Broadview Ave for the two days of the Festival, however **DO NOT** park in a red zone or in front of a driveway or next to a fire hydrant – you **WILL** be cited!

Additional vendor parking is available in the lower parking lot (below the alley) of the Glendale Community College Professional Development Center – GCC-PDC enter on Broadview.

DO NOT PARK IN THE FREE PUBLIC PARKING LOTS! THESE FOR YOUR CUSTOMERS.

ALSO, DO NOT PARK IN THE BANK LOTS ON SATURDAY.

SET UP

Set up time is from 5AM until 9AM on Saturday and from 7AM until 9AM on Sunday. Please be fully unloaded with your vehicle off the street by 9AM. **No vehicles will be allowed to enter the festival area after 9:00 AM.** To prevent gridlock, exhibitors will be required to unload their vehicles and park before setting up their booths. Use entrance and exit points as indicated above. If you will have helpers following in another vehicle, please make sure that they are aware of the entry and exit points. **We will not allow "Early Birds." The police will not allow you to begin setting up or accessing the festival area prior to the official street closure at 5am.**

PARKING

The map provided indicates the location of exhibitor parking. Please do not park in the Bank lots on Saturday. Also, please do not park in the Free Public Parking Lots. We need these spaces for your customers.

CLEAN UP

You are responsible for your own clean up from 6:00 PM – 7:00 PM on Saturday and from 5:00 PM – 6:00 PM on Sunday. You are required to leave your booth in place overnight on Saturday, and although security guards are provided, we encourage you to remove more valuable merchandise. Breakdown of your booth must begin at 5pm – not before - on Sunday and the street must be vacated by 7:30 PM on Sunday.

BOOTH SPACE & MERCHANDISE

All booth spaces are 10' X 10'. Once assigned, spaces cannot be changed – **NO EXCEPTIONS!** The Festival Coordinator reserves the right to revoke the space, without refund, of any artist selling items not made by them. Nearly all applications submitted were accompanied by photographs of the items being sold by each artist. It is expected that these are the items which will be presented for sale in the Festival. If the Festival Coordinator finds items in any booth which are deemed not to be handmade by the exhibitor, they will be asked to remove them and/or leave the Festival.

REFUNDS

Full refunds will be given if cancellations are received prior to May 15, 2024. No refunds will be given after that date.

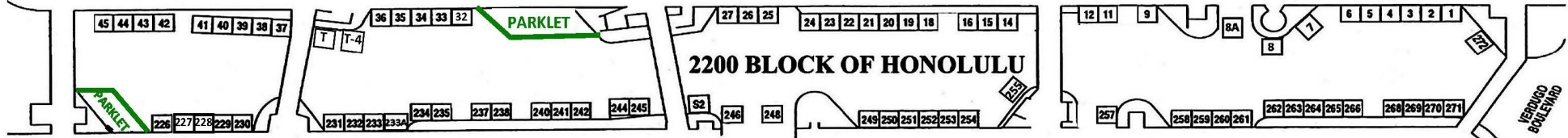

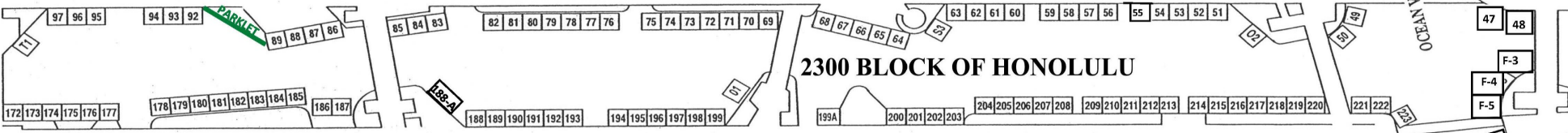

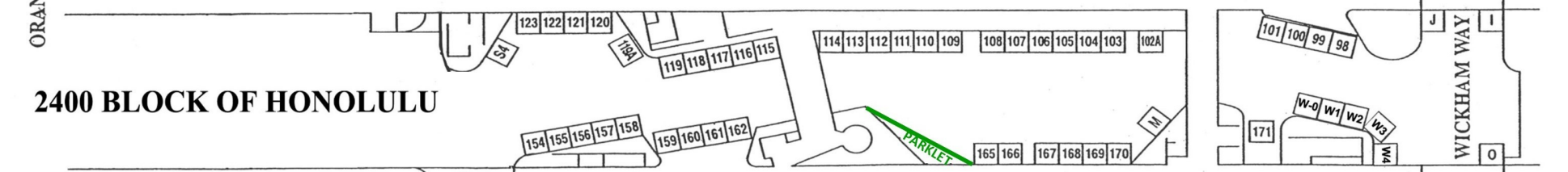
